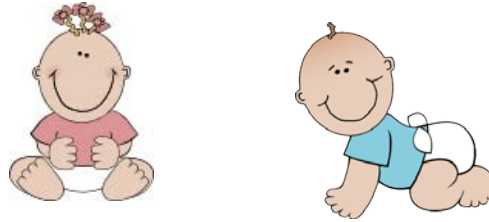
MOTHER'S DAY OUT NOTES

Precious Promises

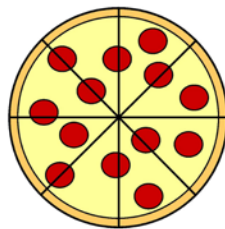
Here it is February already! This year has just flown by so fast for us! We have enjoyed every second of it with your precious little ones!

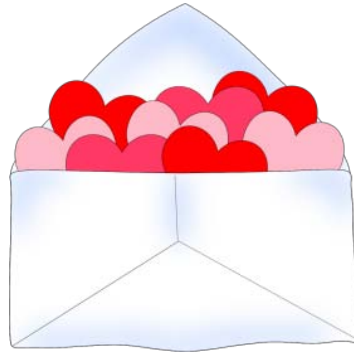
PRESCHOOL & PRE-K NOTES

Wee Wonders

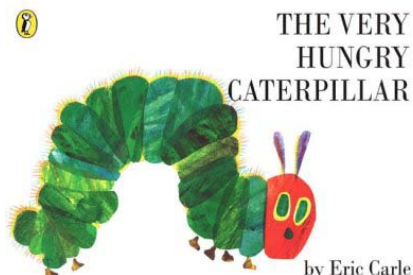
Happy Valentine's Day! I love February! This year is special--it is Leap Year!

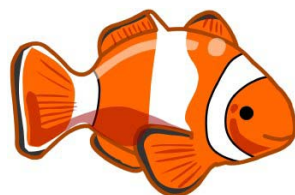

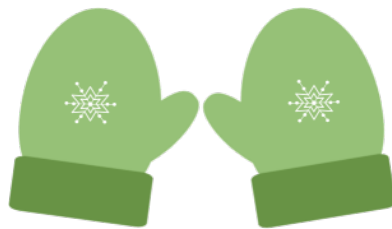

Enrollment Paperwork Checklist:

1. A completed enrollment form for **each** child you are enrolling.
2. A completed emergency medical release form for **each** child you are enrolling.
3. **An up-to-date copy of your child's shot record** so we can make a copy for our records. We will need a copy from you even if you are already in the program and nothing has changed on the shot record.
4. Your \$50 non-refundable registration fee for **each** child you are enrolling.
